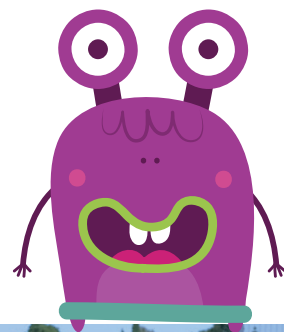

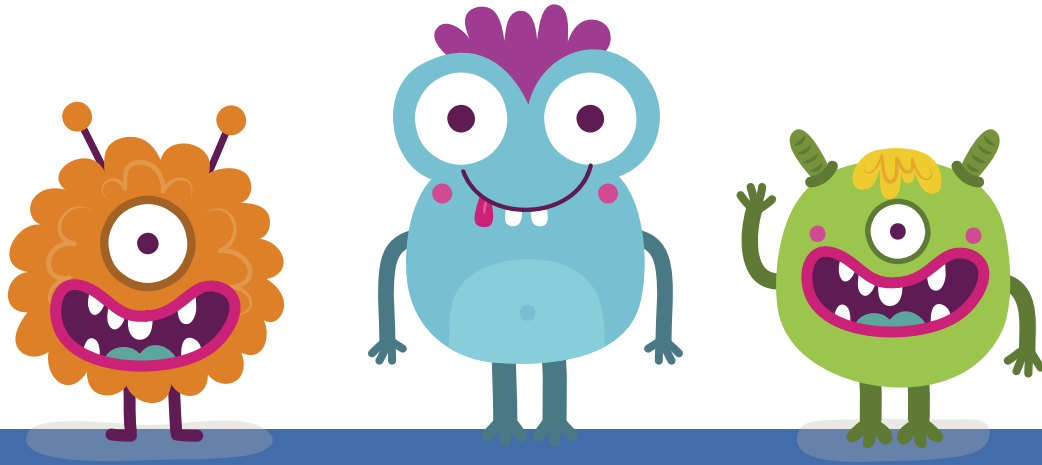

OUR PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOL

- The school is registered with the Gauteng Department of Education with GDE registration no 700401008
- We are an IEB School
- Our code of conduct is aligned to a value system that includes all religions and cultures
- We offer Gr RRR-R (Gr RRR: 3 years old turning 4 years old. Gr RR: 4 years old turning 5 years old. Gr R: 5 years old turning 6 years old)
- We do not accept learners that are on diapers and that still use feeding bottles
- The language of tuition is English
- Learners must be bathroom routine independent and possess basic communication skills
- Our educators are highly qualified and SACE registered
- Every classroom has a laptop, data projector, camera and is connected to Wi-Fi
- Learners receive breakfast and lunch daily (included in school fees)
- Two Meals a day (breakfast and lunch)
- Swimming lessons are included at no additional cost
- Aftercare and holiday aftercare is included in the school fees.

OUR CURRICULUM

The school curriculum is based on the IEB curriculum as well as Regio Emilio. The children learn through play and we focus on the education of the whole child. The learners are capable of constructing their own learning and they learn through interaction with their immediate environment. The learners are encouraged to express themselves through their work.



WHAT PRESCHOOL IS ALL ABOUT

Art is an integral part of our curriculum as we are firm believers in the great impact creativity has on fine motor skills and abstract thinking, which leads to better problem solving skills. We work to unlock every learner's creativity and imagination. At our preschool we give learners many opportunities to experiment with various art material and creative ideas. Learners are given time to cut, paste, mould, build, paint, draw and let loose with their imagination. Learners are encouraged to express themselves through their work.



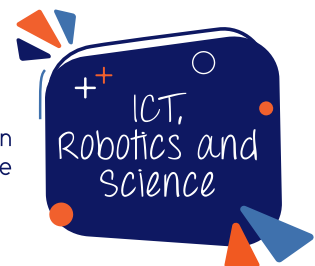
We focus on hand-eye coordination activities to help develop the learners gross motor skills, which helps them prepare for sport in Gr1. We also offer swimming lessons to all our preschool learners during the summer months. On the culture front we offer music, as well as movement, to make sure they get their bodies moving and active.

At Amberfield College we believe in giving back to the community. Learners regularly donate food to the less fortunate. They also donate food, blankets and toys to Wetnose, as well as Dog Town and other deserving charities.



Each term we have educational puppet shows, where we teach the learners about important values and interesting facts about our themes. We also get a visit from firefighters on how to be safe during a fire. A visit from the Mobile Zoo and the Incredible Dog Show takes place to teach the learners how to take care of animals. Hard work is rewarded with fun days. We like to dress up, watch movies, have teddy bear picnics, funky hair days and loads more.

At Amberfield College we offer ICT and Robotics from Gr R. Here our little ones learn about the basics of Computers, Robotics and Coding in a fun and interactive manner. We also do fun experiments to teach colours, weight, sliding and rolling objects.

UNIFORM INFORMATION

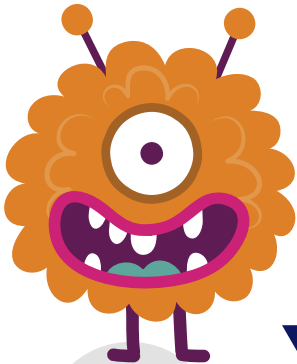
Beginning January 2026, all preschool learners will be wearing casual clothing therefore no uniform will be required.

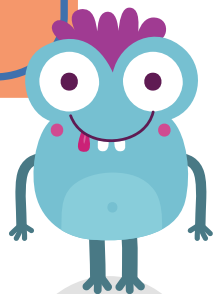

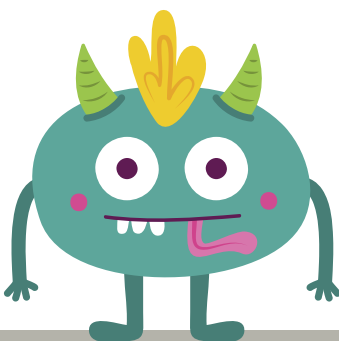
